





Introduction is professional and provides basic information. Consider adding information for the patient about you and your purpose and the estimated length of the encounter. Interview questions flow in a logical manner from chief complaint to overall health information to a three generation family history to body systems. Empathy and education are well addressed in the conversation. Although these are not technically "assessment" such statements help to move the conversation and inquiry forward and reinforce the nurse-client relationship. Appropriate safety considerations pre and post exam were addressed.

Documentation is detailed, organized and presented using professional language. Diet related to diabetes and Social history are significant aspects of the overall health history assessment and should be thoroughly addressed.

Information processing skill is demonstrated by priority setting, evidence and planning.

Hallway is specific to the client history and significant findings during the health history exam. Outstanding Health History!

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
